Sir/Madam,

1. I have the honour to invite you to the joint *International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO)/European Union Aviation Safety Agency (EASA) Third Global Regional Safety Oversight Organizations (RSOOs) and Regional Accident and Incident Investigation Organizations (RAIOs) Forum for Aviation Safety*, which will be held from 29 to 30 September 2026 in Georgetown, Guyana, kindly hosted by the Guyana Civil Aviation Authority. Information on the [First](#) and [Second](#) ICAO/EASA RSOO Forums is available on the ICAO website.

2. Building upon Assembly Resolution A42-10 and past RSOO and RAIO global events, this Forum will allow representatives of RSOOs/RAIOs, Member States, international organizations, industry and ICAO to have substantive dialogue on regional cooperation in aviation safety and accident and incident investigations, and how it contributes to improving Member States' safety oversight and investigative capabilities, ultimately enhancing global aviation safety.

3. The Forum will serve as a high-level platform to exchange experiences, discuss emerging challenges and identify strategic priorities, reaffirming the essential role of regional cooperation in strengthening safety oversight and accident investigation. Discussions will include the contributions of regional mechanisms in supporting States' oversight and accident investigation obligations and the resources required to ensure their continued sustainability. The Forum will also focus on promoting related ICAO guidance material and the RSOO/RAIO Assessment Programme (RRAP), involving RSOOs and RAIOs in the ICAO framework, enhancing collaboration among RSOOs and RAIOs, States, and industry stakeholders, and on identifying practical measures to secure the long-term sustainability of safety oversight and accident and incident investigation systems.
