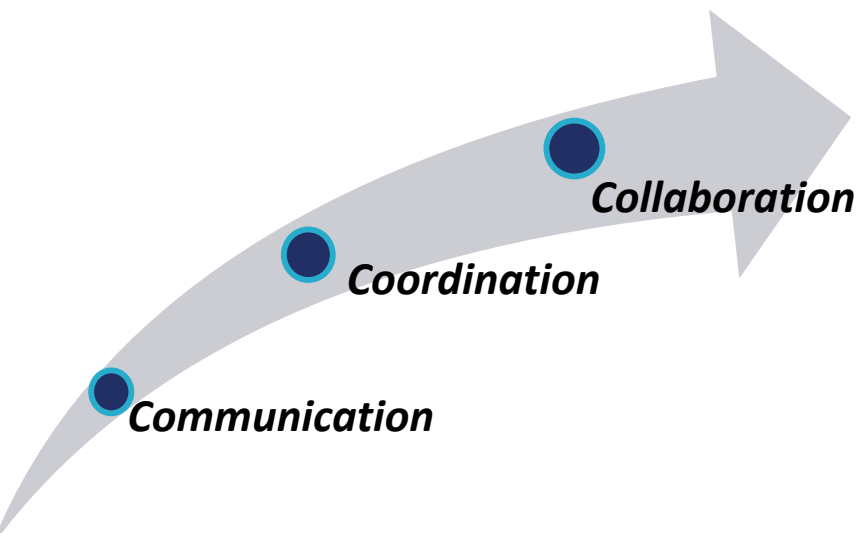
Close coordination and joint activities with ICAO NACC and SAM regional offices and with LACAC

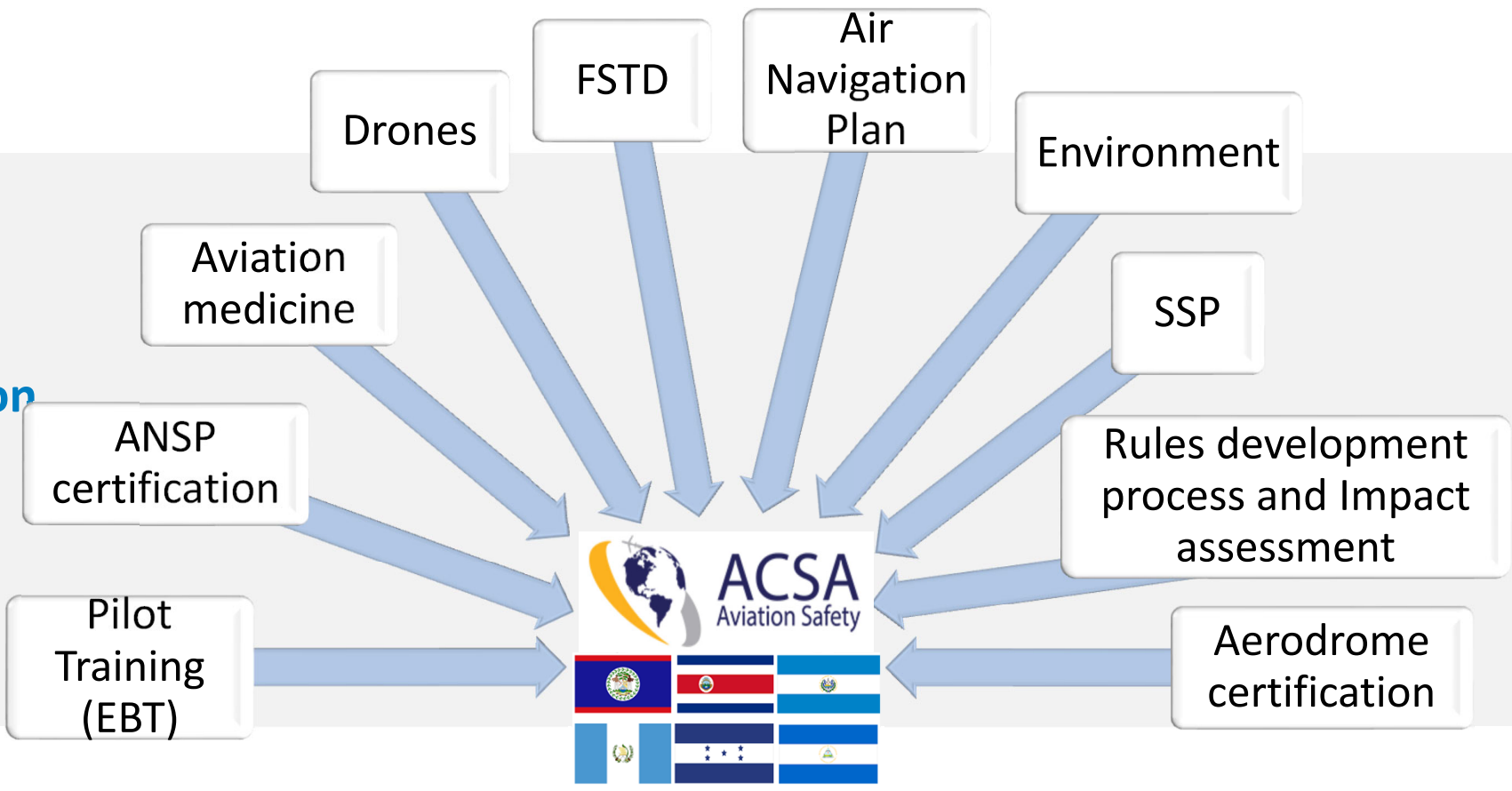

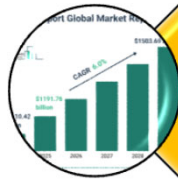
What's next?

- New Project: **EU-Latin America and the Caribbean Cooperation on Civil Aviation (EU-LAC-APP III)**
- Overall objective of the action: *to support technical cooperation and partnership in civil aviation, fostering safe, sustainable and resilient air connectivity in Latin America and the Caribbean*
- Funding
 - Budget: 2 M€
 - Source: EU Commission
- Duration: 3 years / Estimated start period: Q2 2026
- Building on the results and activities of the two previous concluded technical cooperation projects EU-LAC APP II and EU-CORSIA Caribbean encompassing safety, air transport and sustainability dimensions

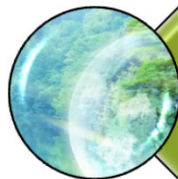
