On 9 December, 2025, ICAO will celebrate International Anti-Corruption Day to raise awareness on global corruption and on ways to fight this crime. In this context, we would like to take this opportunity to remind all our vendors and suppliers about ICAO's expectations in this regard - ICAO has zero tolerance for fraud and corruption.

For us to collectively achieve the ICAO's mandate, it is imperative to ensure that every contribution to ICAO is used as efficiently as possible. As a current or prospective vendor/supplier of ICAO, we thank you for having in place appropriate mechanisms to ensure compliance with the UN Supplier Code of Conduct. We also kindly remind you that vendors and suppliers participating in a procurement process must disclose any actual, potential, or perceived conflict of interest in relation to a prospective or ongoing contractual relationship with ICAO. At the same time, to avoid any conflicts of interest situations (which could also lead to corruption and fraud), and to protect ICAO from any appearance of impropriety, all ICAO personnel, regardless of contract type or duration, are prohibited from accepting gifts from any source external to ICAO - including vendors and suppliers - which include hospitality, promotional items, accommodations, tokens of appreciation, invitations to and tickets for entertainment events and/or anything of value.

To make good faith reports of wrongdoing, including requests for anything of value by ICAO personnel in any form in exchange for business favoritism with ICAO or for personal gain, fraud and/or corruption, please contact directly the Investigations Division of the United Nations Office of Internal Oversight Services (OIOS) by using this <u>link</u>.
