# **RASG-PA Objectives**

- Develop an integrated, data-driven strategy and implement a work programme that supports a regional performance framework for the management of safety risk, to reduce the commercial aviation fatality risk in the Pan American Region and promote States and industry safety initiatives; and
- Support, monitor and report implementation by States of the Global Aviation Safety Plan (GASP, Doc 10004) considering the Regional Aviation Safety Plans, and by fostering cooperation between all States and stakeholders.





### Link to GASP

 Each ICAO Region contributes to the improvement of global aviation safety and the achievement of safety objectives identified in the GASP by working to identify and reduce, within the Region, the key contributing factors that have been associated to Global High Risk Categories of occurrences (G-HRCs).

### **PA-RAST Activities**

- Gather and analyze Safety data and intelligence
- Identify safety issues for action in Pan America Region
- Recommend safety objectives, priorities and indicators
- Undertake Safety Analysis Projects
- Design Initiatives/Detailed Implementation Plans (SEI/DIP) to reduce fatality risk
- Foster local/regional cooperation between States and industry stakeholders





# PA-RAST Meetings

- Quarterly <u>In-Person</u> Meeting Calendar
  - Spring and Fall: ICAO NACC (Mexico) and SAM (Lima) Offices
  - Winter and Summer: Locations in the Americas (hosted by States or industry members)
- Ad-hoc Meetings (in-person or hybrid)
  - Facilitation of State Collaborative Safety Team (CST) development
  - High-risk Category (HRC) project sub-groups
  - Support to Safety Monitoring and Reporting Team (SMRT)





# Typical PA-RAST Meeting

- Industry day
  - First part of meeting reserved for safety topics raised by industry stakeholders in the region
- PA-RAST Project Updates
  - Project leads provide progress updates on initiatives and receive feedback and strategic direction from group
- CST Development Updates
- Safety Data Review
  - Review of Flight data from various sources to highlight hot spots and potential safety action to be considered by PA-RAST
- Administrative items

#### Elevating issues at regional level


Share local issues facilitating identification of systemic issues across a region







# PA-RAST - CST Strategy







### **CSTs at PA-RAST**

- Any local CST can be a partner of PA-RAST and have an active member attend PA-RAST meetings
- Participation at in-person meetings can facilitate awareness, engagement and support between PA-RAST and individual CSTs as well as a platform to exchange best practices among safety experts
- PA-RAST can contribute available safety intelligence to evaluate local safety issues, and help in the design and implementation of local safety enhancements
- Local or domestic safety issues identified by CSTs can be reported at the PA-RAST level, to facilitate identification of systemic issues across CSTs in the Region
- PA-RAST can help a CST connect with another CST in the region
