Refueling Units positioned within certain Aircraft Stand Positions (PEAs) at the New Jorge Chávez Airport

Operational Safety Assessment – Permanent Location of Refueling Units within Aircraft Stand.

Purpose:

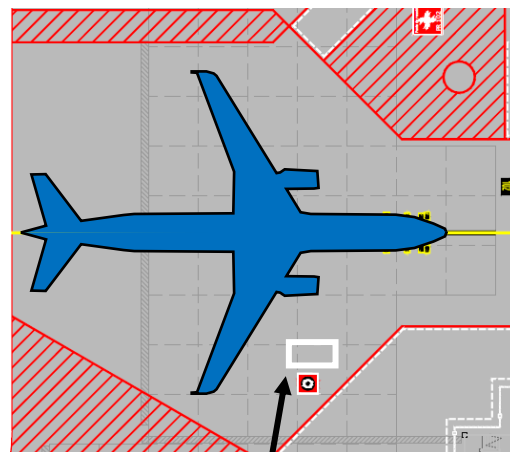
To familiarize operators at the new Jorge Chávez Airport with the newly authorized fuel replenishment equipment approved by the aeronautical authority.

Details:

The new terminal has been equipped with permanently positioned fuel units located within certain aircraft stand positions. This new arrangement, implemented by the airport operator, has undergone an operational safety assessment and has been approved by the DGAC.



The fuel units are located at certain aircraft stand positions designated for the operation of category “C” aircraft.



Reference position of the fuel unit

The fuel units will be located in a marked area forward of and below the rear third of the aircraft's right wing.



Always ensure the proper positioning of the fuel unit before the aircraft enters the stand — **Safety always comes first**
