Within the framework of the activities programme of the Regional Project RLA/06/901, I am pleased to invite your Administration to participate in the Regional Meeting on Minimum Operational Networks (MON) and GNSS Resilience in the SAM Region, which will be held virtually from 13 to 17 July 2026.
