Subject: **PBN Flight Procedure Design On-The-Job training Course
Dakar, Senegal, 5 to 30 October 2026**

Action required: Nominate candidates by 21 September 2026.

Sir/Madam,

I have the honour to invite your Administration to nominate candidates for the PBN Flight Procedure Design On-the-Job Training (OJT) course, to be organized by the African Flight Procedure Programme (AFPP) at its premises in Dakar, Senegal, from **5 to 30 October 2026**.

The course aims to assist States and Air Navigation Service Providers in developing and strengthening their capacity in flight procedure design or oversight. It is intended for air navigation professionals who have successfully completed the Instrument Flight Procedure (IFP) Design Initial Training Course, covering both conventional and PBN procedures.

The OJT will enable participants to consolidate the knowledge and skills acquired during their initial training through the manual design of PBN flight procedures. Each candidate must therefore select a national aerodrome for the design exercise and provide the relevant design data. This should include paper or electronic maps at appropriate scales (1:50,000; 1:100,000; 1:200,000), as long as runway, meteorological, obstacle, and Aeronautical Information Publication (AIP) data for the selected aerodrome.

To ensure proper coordination and equitable participation, only candidates officially nominated by their Civil Aviation Administration, Air Navigation Service Provider or another competent authority will be considered. Applications submitted directly by individuals will not be accepted.

Participation is free of charge for AFPP Members in good standing with their annual financial contributions. Subject to availability, applications from non-members and other users may be considered at a fee of USD 4,000 per participant. Travel, accommodation, and daily subsistence expenses will be borne by the nominating Administration.

The course and all related documentation will be in English. An information bulletin, including a list of recommended hotels in Dakar, is attached.

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As enrolment is limited to 15 participants, your administration is invited to nominate no more than two qualified candidates by 21 September 2026, indicating their order of priority, where applicable. Each nomination should be accompanied by a completed registration form and the candidate's résumé.
