Subject: ATS safety events data collection

Action required: Submission of ATS safety event investigation reports and occurrence notifications for 2024 and 2025 by 20 August 2026

Sir/Madam,

I wish to refer to Conclusion 6/04 of the joint meeting of APIRG/27 and RASG-AFI/10, which called for the restart of activities related to AFI ATS events analysis through the periodic and regular provision by States of comprehensive incidents data and other events to support regional safety analysis and oversight activities.

In support of the implementation of this Conclusion, States, Air Navigation Service Providers (ANSPs), Airport Operators and Air Operators are requested to share copies of relevant ATS related safety events investigation reports and/or ATS safety occurrences notifications. These reports are essential to facilitate the preparation and the conduct of the AFI ATS Events Analysis Group (AEAG) annual meeting which reviews and analyses ATS safety events, identifies safety trends and develops recommendations to address emerging safety concerns.

The second meeting of the AFI ATS Events Analysis Group (AEAG) is tentatively planned for the second week of October 2026. The effectiveness of this meeting will depend on the timely availability of relevant safety event data. Accordingly, you are kindly requested to submit ATS safety event investigation reports and/or ATS safety occurrence notifications covering the years 2024 and 2025 to the relevant Regional Safety Oversight Organization (RSOO) — AAMAC, BAGASOO, CASSOA or SASO — no later than **20 August 2026**, with copies to (stchanda@icao.int) and (BThendu@icao.int).
