1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The activities of the AFI-AMP-COMP Project Team were launched on 11 May 2026 during the kick-off meeting organized by the Secretariat.
- 1.2 The main objective of the AFI-AMP-COMP Project is to provide support to States in implementing ICAO SARPs and ASBU elements through the project management approach.
- 1.3 Specifically, this project aims to strengthen the implementation of the Aeronautical Meteorological Personnel (AMP) Competency Framework in the AFI Region.
- 1.4 This paper summarizes the achievements of the project team activities to date.

2. DISCUSSIONS

- 2.1 Following the launch of the project, the Project Team developed an **action plan** and a **roadmap**, which were validated at an online meeting held on 12 June 2026. These documents are available in the project workspace.
- 2.2 The Project Team subsequently developed an online questionnaire on the implementation of the AMP competency standards in the AFI Region. The questionnaire will be distributed to AFI States through the ICAO ESAF and WACAF Offices and can be accessed at: <https://forms.cloud.microsoft/r/4SLXA3uyg0>
- 2.3 Furthermore, the project team developed competency frameworks for AMF and AMO, based on WMO-No.1205 and WMO-No.1209. These competency frameworks include a list and description of top-level competencies and associated performance criteria, which are expressed and structured in such a manner as to facilitate the implementation of assessment procedures. This document is available in the project workspace.
- 2.4 Current activities focus on identifying the evidence associated with each performance criterion, as well as the methods and tools to be used for their assessment.
