**Subject:** PBN Flight Procedure Design Training Course, Nairobi, Kenya, from 2 to 27 February 2026.

**Action required** Reply to confirm participation not later than **19 January 2025**.

Sir/Madam,

I have the honour to invite your Administration to the PBN Flight Procedure Design Course, organized by the African Flight Procedure Programme (AFPP) in collaboration with the East African School of Aviation (EASA), to be held in Nairobi, Kenya, from 2 to 27 February 2026.

This course aims to strengthen the capacity of States and Air Navigation Service Providers in instrument flight procedure design. As the second phase of the flight procedure designer training curriculum, it will provide practical instruction in the development of IFR trajectories based on PBN concepts and criteria. Topics include the PBN framework, applicable regulations, and hands-on design of SIDs, STARs, and Non-Precision and APV baro-VNAV approaches.

Eligible nominees shall be air navigation subject-matter experts who have previously completed the conventional flight procedure design course. Demonstrated proficiency in the English language is required. Priority consideration will be accorded to candidates who participated in the AFPP Initial IFPD Course held in October 2025.

The course will be conducted in English. The draft agenda, training programme, information bulletin and list of suggested hotels are attached. Participants are encouraged to bring laptops, scientific calculators and USB devices, as hard-copy material will be limited.

The training is free of charge for AFPP active members in good standing. Other States and Organizations may be considered subject to availability of space, with a tuition fee of USD 4,000 per participant. Travel, accommodation and living expenses remain the responsibility of the nominating entity.

Enrollment is limited to 24 participants. You are therefore invited to nominate up to two qualified candidates not later than 19 January 2026, indicating priority where applicable. Candidates must be officially nominated by their Administration, and each nomination must include the resume.
