1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The AASPG Safety Management and Oversight Sub-Group (SMO/SG) is responsible for supporting the implementation of ICAO Standards and Recommended Practices (SARPs), as well as carrying out activities that enable the AASPG to fulfil its safety management and safety oversight functions and responsibilities.
- 1.2 The first meeting of the Africa-Indian Ocean Aviation System Planning and Implementation Group (AASPG/1), which replaced the APIRG and the RASG-AFI, took place in Libreville, Gabon, from 3 to 7 November 2025.
- 1.3 The SMO/SG was established at a meeting held in Nairobi, Kenya, from 24 to 25 April 2025. This was followed by the first SMO/SG meeting, which was conducted virtually from 2 to 5 September 2025.
- 1.4 The first SMO/SG meeting resulted in one (1) conclusion and two (2) decisions, while the first AASPG meeting resulted in three (3) conclusions and six (6) decisions related to the sub-group.

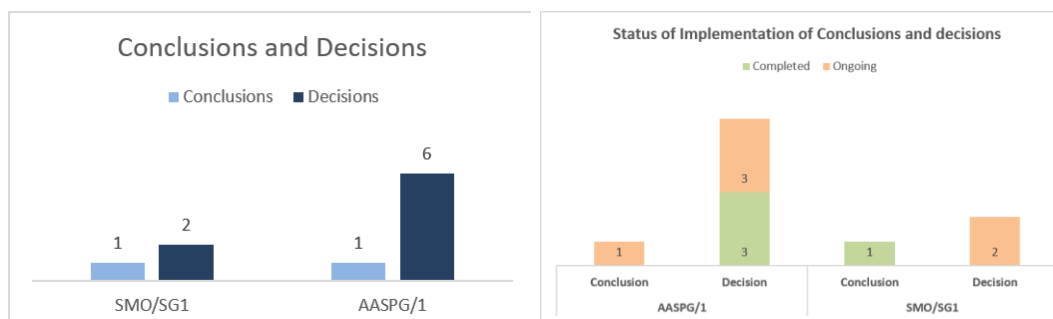


Figure 1: Summary of the Status of Implementation

2.1. Figure 1 provides a summary of the implementation status.
