

## Birth of the Collaborative Implementation Programme

- The 1<sup>st</sup> AFI Aviation Safety Symposium in Dakar, Senegal, 27 28 May 2014 mainly discussed among other things:-
  - The status of aviation safety and air navigation performance in the AFI Region;
  - Progress towards the attainment of the regional aviation safety targets - Abuja Safety Targets; and
  - Regional performance objectives for air navigation systems.
- This Symposium yielded the Collaborative Implementation Programme, which was presented to the 13th meeting of the AFI Plan Steering Committee.
- The CIP was eventually integrated into the AFI Plan work programme and presented to the 14<sup>th</sup>AFI Plan SC meeting.

#### **Collaborative Implementation –Initiatives with Partners**

- Support to the Improvement of Aviation Safety in Africa (SIASA)- EU fund
  - Assistance missions to States,
  - Development of Regulations and guidance materials,
  - Provision of Workshops and Training,
    - ✓ SOFIA
    - ✓ ECCAIRS etc.
- United States Technical Assistance
  - Seminars/ Workshops and training on strategies for managing an effective ATM oversight organization.
- IATA Operational Safety Audit (IOSA)
  - Assist Airlines to prepare for the IOSA Audit
  - Support in the establishment of the AOC database

# **Collaborative Implementation –Initiatives with Partners**

- African Civil Aviation Commission AFI Cooperative Inspectorate Scheme (AFI-CIS)
  - Assist States to resolve safety oversight deficiencies with priorities on the resolution of Significant Safety Concerns (SSCs) and improvement of the rate of Effective Implementation (EI) of the SARPs.
- Enhanced implementation of PBN through the African FPP

# **Collaborative Implementation –Initiatives with Partners**

- Regional Aviation Safety Group for the AFI region (RASG-AFI)
  - Support to States in the establishment of Runway Safety Teams at International Airports;
  - Detailed Implementation Plans of Loss of Control in Flight (LOC-I) toolkit;
  - Development of Projects on Accident Investigation and Fundamentals of Safety Oversight.

# **CIP Implementation Progress / Results**

- RASG –AFI Runway Safety Go-teams established at X airports;
- Two States(Zambia and ......) supported in the development of Regulations and manuals;
- Many seminars/workshops and training related to aviation safety provided;
- ROST assistance missions provided to X States;
- Support provided to many African states through AFI- CIS Support provided to 15 African Airlines to prepare for IOSA.

## **CIP Implementation Challenges**

- Duplication of efforts in some programmes and projects;
- Establishment of clear time-bound common target and priorities;
- Proper coordination of activities and work programmes;

#### **Recommendations on CIP Implementation**

- Establish a common set of priorities and goals,
- Extend NCLB to all ICAO Strategic Objectives,
- Devise a strategy that values the strength of individual partners,
- Popularize annual goals,
- Mutual exchange and sharing of programmes of activities and,
- Assistance on result based specific activities.
