Developments in Annex 9

- FALP/9's **proposals** (considered by Council in early 2017):
 - New API Standard
 - Enhanced PNR-related provisions
 - New recommendations for Electronic Travel Systems (ETS)
 - Nationality of passengers in Passenger Manifest
 - New provisions on transport of minors by air
- A39: priorities for Annex 9 and expected outcomes for the 2017-2019 triennium

Developments pertaining to ICAO TRIP

- 1st meeting of TAG/TRIP (formerly TAG/MRTD)
- Primary on-going activities of TAG/TRIP include:
 - development and maintenance of MRTD specifications and technical guidance
 - monitoring non-compliant MRPs and eMRPs
 - establishment of a Doc 9303 compliance scheme for MRTDs/eMRTDs
 - development of guidance on evidence of identity
- Future work programme includes:
 - use of mobile credentials as globally enabled travel documents
 - issues faced by small-island States
 - policy issues related to advanced technologies on MRTDs and eMRTDs

Developments pertaining to the ICAO Public Key Directory (PKD)

- Currently 54 members
- To encourage participation, Annex 9's RPs:
 - one aimed at document issuers
 - one aimed at border control authorities
- Importance of PKD for enhancing cross-border security and air transport facilitation
