

Dr. Bader S. Alsagri was appointed Representative of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia on the Council Council on 11 June 2021. Dr. Alsagri has since been elected as the 3rd Vice-President of the Council (2022-2023) and as Chair of both the Aviation Security Committee and the Small Group on Developing ICAO's Leadership on Economic Development of Air Transport (2023-2024) a testimony to his commitment to fostering the Safe, Secure, and sustainable and economic growth of the International Civil Aviation sector.

Prior to his posting at ICAO, Dr. Alsagri held significant roles at the Saudi General Authority of Civil Aviation including as Vice-President of Economic Policies and Air Transport, Director for International Cooperation and Board Member to the General Authority of Foreign Trade, representing the Ministry of Transport.

Dr. Alsagri holds a PhD in International Law from China University of Political Science and Law (2013), an MBA from the Australian National University (2007), and a BSc in Aviation Business Administration from the Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University.

He served as the Director General of the Foreign Trade Relations Directorate, where he managed bilateral relations across diverse regions including Africa, Asia, Europe, and the Americas. His adept negotiation skills led him to become the lead negotiator for over 20 government bilateral agreements.

In addition to his negotiation roles, Dr. Alsagri was appointed as Saudi's G20 Trade and Investment Subcommittee leader and served as Saudi Arabia's head representative for the 2016 G20 Trade and Investment working group.

Throughout the course of his extensive career, Dr. Alsagri has consistently represented the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia with distinction on various international platforms, substantively contributing to the enhancement of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia's international relations.
