# REPORTING ON CO<sub>2</sub> EMISSIONS (2019 and 2020)

According to Annex 16, Volume IV, Part II, Chapter 2, 2.3.2.2, for the years 2019 and 2020, each "State shall submit a report to ICAO" that contains the total annual  $CO_2$  emissions per State pair aggregated for all aeroplane operators attributed to the State (in tonnes) as per Appendix 5, Table A5-4. For the purposes of the CCR, information on  $CO_2$  emissions must be provided in separate fields, as shown below.

### Information on CO<sub>2</sub> Emissions (mandatory fields are shown with a \*)

#### For each State pair:

- From (Departing State)\*
- ➤ To (Arrival State)\*
- ➤ CO₂ Emissions\*
- Confidential Data

### Reporting Deadline


For 2019 data: by 31 August 2020
For 2020 data: by 31 August 2021

### **Reporting Tips**

- $\succ$  Starting in 2020, each year, submit to ICAO (through the CCR) CO $_2$  emissions for the previous year
- $\succ$  "CO $_2$  Emissions" are the total aggregated emissions on the State pair for all aeroplane operators attributed to your State; the value (in tonnes of CO $_2$ ) must be positive, and you can provide up to two decimal points
- > Annex 16, Volume IV defines a State pair as a "group of two States composed of a departing State or its territories and an arrival State or its territories"
  - ✓ For two States (e.g., State A and State B), emissions for the State pair A-B must be provided separately from the emissions for the State pair B-A
- $\succ$  When CO<sub>2</sub> emissions are considered 'confidential', you can indicate this by clicking on the tick box in the web form or adding TRUE in a CSV file
- $\succ$  In addition to the information above, you can use the <u>Remarks</u> field to provide additional information about the CO<sub>2</sub> emissions for a specific year report



# **REPORTING PROCESS**



### Create Year Report - FOR CORSIA FOCAL POINT ONLY



> On the "Report CO<sub>2</sub> Emissions" page, click on "Add", then:

#### Create an empty Year Report

- ✓ Select "Quick Add"
- √ Select the reporting year (2019 or 2020)
- ✓ Click on "Create"

## Add or Edit CO<sub>2</sub> Emissions (for State pairs)



- $\gt$  On the "Report CO<sub>2</sub> Emissions" page, select the year report (2019 or 2020) by clicking on the pencil icon next to it
- > To add CO<sub>2</sub> Emissions for State pairs
  - ✓ Select the "CO₂ Emissions (State pairs)" tab of the year report, then:

#### **OPTION 1: Add manually**

- ✓ Click on "Add", then "Full Add"
- ✓ Complete information on web form
- ✓ Click on "Create"
- √ Repeat as needed

#### **OPTION 2: Import CSV file**

- ✓ Click on "Tools", then "Import CSV"
- ✓ Locate the CSV file on your computer
- ✓ Click on "Upload"
- ✓ Click on "Confirm and Continue Import"
- > To edit CO<sub>2</sub> Emissions for a State pair
  - ✓ Select the "CO<sub>2</sub> Emissions (State Pairs)" tab of the year report
  - ✓ Select the State pair you want to edit by clicking on the pencil icon next to it.
  - ✓ Make changes on the web form that will appear on your screen
  - ✓ Click on "Save"
- > After having finished adding and editing all CO<sub>2</sub> Emissions for State pairs
  - √ Select the "Details" tab of the year report
  - ✓ Under "Data Status", select UNDER REVIEW and click on "Save"
