## **Outcomes of CAAF/3**



- Adoption of a new ICAO Global Framework for Sustainable Aviation Fuels (SAF), Lower Carbon Aviation Fuels (LCAF) and other Aviation Cleaner Energies.
- Collective global aspirational Vision to reduce CO2
   emissions in international aviation by 5 per cent
   by 2030, compared to zero cleaner energy use.
- Support the clean energy transition of the aviation sector needed to achieve the current goal of Net-Zero carbon emissions by 2050







## **Outcomes of CAAF/3**



#### 1. Policy and Planning

- Collective global aspirational Vision to reduce CO2 emissions in international aviation by 5 per cent by 2030 through the use of SAF, LCAF and other cleaner energies (compared to zero cleaner energy use).
- States are encouraged to implement policies in support of the Vision; harmonization of policies amongst States is encouraged.
- The role of State Action Plans is recognized.
- The Vision is a collaborative effort with action required from different stakeholders.
- Monitoring and reviewing the global framework, including through annual ICAO stocktaking and the convening of CAAF/4 no later than 2028.

#### 3. Implementation support

- All States should have access to the means to participate across all stages of the development and deployment of SAF, LCAF and other aviation cleaner energies; work together in a spirit of solidarity.
- Need for robust and substantial capacity-building and implementation support programme; ICAO capacity-building and implementation support to be delivers under the one-ICAO approach.
- Access to technology for States to contribute to, and benefit from, cleaner energy development and deployment.
- ICAO should regularly monitor the progress and effectiveness of the capacity-building and implementation support efforts.

#### 2. Regulatory Framework

- Use the CORSIA sustainability framework as the accepted basis for the eligibility of SAF, LCAF and other aviation cleaner energies.
- Increase the number of ICAO approved SCS, in all regions.
- Accelerate the certification of additional fuel production pathways.
- Accounting methodologies such as the CORSIA MRV, provides confidence in the use of such fuels; States agreed on a set of parameters and further work from CAEP to undertake a study of fuel accounting systems for international aviation currently used in the open market.

#### 4. Financing cleaner energy

- The primary objective for ICAO and its Member States with respect to financing should be to support countries in particular developing countries and States with particular needs, to improve access to low-cost financing and funding, and further de-risking of projects.
- The need for significant cooperation and collaboration between stakeholders to mitigate investment risk.
- Key role of ICAO, States and industry in advocating for greater investment in SAF, LCAF and other cleaner energy projects.
- Support to Finvest Hub and request to urgently operationalize the initiative.

#### TEMPLATE FOR FEASIBILITY STUDIES ON SUSTAINABLE AVIATION FUELS

The ICAO Assistance, Capacity-building and Training for Sustainable Aviation Fuels (ACT-SAF) Programme was launched in June 2022. Its objective is to enable States to develop their full potential in SAF development and deployment, in line with the ICAO's No Country Left Behind initiative, the 2050 ICAO Vision for SAF, and the three main pillars of sustainable development recognized by the United Nations.

This template has been developed in the context of the ICAO ACT-SAF Programme to facilitate the preparation of standardized feasibility studies on SAF. The template can be used to assess the feasibility of SAF development and deployment both at the State and Regional level. ICAO has developed an interactive guide to assist in the preparation of feasibility studies following the structure defined in this template (link to be provided once the guide is developed).

The information to be included in a feasibility study will be determined by the preparer to demonstrate the potential for the SAF development and deployment in the State under consideration. To ensure the consistency of information across different feasibility studies, it is recommended that all sections of the template be elaborated in a clear and concise manner. In parts where this may not be applicable, an appropriate explanation should be provided. It should also be noted that this template is by no means exhaustive, and a feasibility study may incorporate additional elements as appropriate.'

The structure of the template is summarized as follows (to be reviewed upon finalization of template):

- Executive Summary
- Section 1: State-specific Information
- Section 2: Evaluation of Feedstocks and Pathways for SAF Production
- Section 3: Implementation Support and Financing
- Section 4: Action Plan








#### **Overall Satisfaction**



#### Strong need for support in SAF feasibility studies


- Half (50%) wanted to be considered for SAF feasibility studies, with additional follow up support (e.g. business case development) where applicable
- Others (28%) wanted more information before committing to a request
- Remainder (22%) expressed that this was not applicable
  - Responses mainly from organizations, States which have already completed feasibility studies
- Implementation of feasibility studies will be a key item on the agenda for ICAO in 2024

# Scale up of SAF feasibility studies thanks to financial contributions from or cooperation with:

- European Union: 10 SAF feasibility studies in Cameroon, Egypt, Equatorial Guinea, Ethiopia, India, Gabon, Mauritania, Mozambique, Senegal and South Africa.
- France: Business Implementation report in Ethiopia and studies in 2 or 3 other States;
- Netherlands: feasibility studies in 3 States (Jordan and Chile + 1 TBC);
- United Kingdom: 3 SAF feasibility studies + SAF training for 3 States;
- Austria: to be announced;
- Cote d'Ivoire: to be announced;
- Airbus: 3 Feasibility Studies in South America
