Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy sets out how ICAO uses and protects any information that you provide to the Organization when you use the ICAO USOAP CMA Community website. Personal Information We Collect

We may collect the following information:

- Users' names and contact information, including email address
- Demographic information such as location, preferences and interests
- Other information relevant to the purpose of the USOAP CMA Community.

Use of Your Personal Information

We require certain personal information to better understand and serve your needs. We also use this information to improve our communication and services to Member States.

Controlling Your Personal Information

We will not sell, distribute or release your personal information to third parties unless we have your permission or are required by law to do so.

If you believe that any of your personal information we have on file is incorrect or incomplete, please notify us to correct it.

Information Security

Information provided to us is held with the utmost care. We employ a range of physical and electronic information management procedures to protect private information maintained on our systems from unauthorized access, disclosure or misuse.

All our staff who have access to, and are associated with the processing of personal data, are obliged to respect the confidentiality of official business matters, including personal information.

Use of Cookies

A cookie is a small file, which with your permission is placed on your computer. Cookies allow us to identify your personal preferences and website visits. When you revisit the website, your setting will be stored, and the website will appear in accordance with your preferences.

We use cookies to monitor web traffic and improve our web content and services. Data that are no longer needed are removed from our system.

Cookies do not give access to your computer or any personal information, other than the one you choose to share with us. You can always accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers are set automatically to accept cookies, but you could modify your settings to decline cookies, if you prefer. However, this may limit your access and experience with the ICAO USOAP CMA Community website.
