At 11:51, the flight BMM 2091 took off on runway 22 of the aerodrome of Metz Nancy Lorraine to destination of Marrakech.

The ongoing work at the aerodrome, begun the evening before, limited the distance available for takeoff. The crew did not know of these restrictions and planned the takeoff with the normal runway length.

During the takeoff, the airplane blew over the provisional lights at the temporary threshold 04 and flew low over the frangible barrier three hundred meters further. The flight continued to Marrakech. The crew was warned during descent that the temporary barriers were knocked over during takeoff from Metz; it made a precautionary landing.
