**NOTES**

<sup>1</sup> Acceptance of this Protocol is deemed by virtue of adherence to the Convention, as provided by Article V of the Protocol.

<sup>2</sup> Declaration: “At the time of accession to this Convention, the Principality of Andorra has no airport or airfield, although it does have a heliport and helistations.”

<sup>3</sup> Declaration: “At the time of its accession to the Convention, Andorra, while possessing heliports and several helistations, has no airport or airfield in its territory, and no aircraft is registered in its records.”

<sup>4</sup> Declaration: “At the time of its accession to the Convention and to the Protocol, Andorra, while possessing heliports and several helistations, has no airport or airfield in its territory, and no aircraft is registered in its records.”

<sup>5</sup> The instrument of accession by the Government of Andorra contains the following “declarations”:  
“A. In accordance with paragraph 2 of Article XIII of the Convention on the Marking of Plastic Explosives for the Purpose of Detection, the Principality of Andorra declares that it is not a producer State of plastic explosives.

B. The Principality of Andorra declares that it does not presently have the necessary infrastructures to exercise an effective control over imported explosives. However, the Principality of Andorra undertakes to purchase explosives from States parties to the Convention on the Marking of Plastic Explosives for the Purpose of Detection in such a way that the explosives have already been the subject of a control in the countries of origin or transit.”

The instrument of accession was accompanied by a Note from the Embassy of the Principality of Andorra to Canada which stated that the declarations contained in the instrument were “exclusively explanatory, since the Andorran State has undertaken to implement all the provisions of the Convention in all their scope”.
