- <sup>1</sup> The Government of the Czech Republic succeeded to this international air law instrument on 13/12/94.
- <sup>2</sup> Signed with reservation as to acceptance.
- <sup>3</sup> By a declaration dated 14 November 1994, transmitted with a note dated 24 November 1994 from the Embassy of the Czech Republic in Warsaw, the Government of the Czech Republic declared that it considered itself bound, by virtue of succession, by the provisions of, *inter alia*, the Warsaw Convention and The Hague Protocol (with effect from 1 January 1993).
- <sup>4</sup> The Government of the Czech Republic succeeded to this international air law instrument on 5/12/94, with effect from 1/1/93.
- <sup>5</sup> By a Note dated 8/3/93, received on 25/3/93, the Government of the Czech Republic informed ICAO that:

“In harmony with the valid principles of international law and to the extent defined by it, the Czech Republic, as a successor State created as a result of the dissolution of the Czech and Slovak Federal Republic, considers itself bound, as of January 1, 1993, i.e., the date of the dissolution of the Czechoslovak Federation, by multilateral international treaties to which the Czech and Slovak Federal Republic was a party on that date, including reservations and statements to their provisions made earlier by Czechoslovakia”.

The above declaration applies to the following international air law instruments for which ICAO is the depositary. Reservations/declarations made by the former Czechoslovakia which continue in force for the Czech Republic are indicated.

- 1) Agreement on the Joint Financing of Certain Air Navigation Services in Greenland and the Faroe Islands, signed at Geneva on 25/9/56, with a reservation that, with respect to paragraph 2 of Article XXI of the Agreement, the Government of the Czech Republic does not consent to making any contributions for any period prior to 1/1/65 (i.e. beginning of year in which the former Czechoslovakia acceded to the Agreement);
- 2) Agreement on the Joint Financing of Certain Air Navigation Services in Iceland, signed at Geneva on 25/9/56, with a reservation that, with respect to paragraph 2 of Article XXI of the Agreement, the Government of the Czech Republic does not consent to making any contributions for any period prior to 1/1/65 (i.e. beginning of year in which the former Czechoslovakia acceded to the Agreement);
- 3) Convention on Offences and Certain Other Acts Committed on Board Aircraft, signed at Tokyo on 14/9/63;
- 4) Protocol for the Amendment of the 1956 Agreement on the Joint Financing of Certain Air Navigation Services in Greenland and the Faroe Islands, signed at Montreal on 3/11/82;

- 5) Protocol for the Amendment of the 1956 Agreement on the Joint Financing of Certain Air Navigation Services in Iceland, signed at Montreal on 3/11/82;
- 6) Protocol for the Suppression of Unlawful Acts of Violence at Airports Serving International Civil Aviation, Supplementary to the Convention for the Suppression of Unlawful Acts against the Safety of Civil Aviation, done at Montreal on 23/9/71, signed at Montreal on 24/2/88;
- 7) Convention on the Marking of Plastic Explosives for the Purpose of Detection, done at Montreal on 1/3/91, with a declaration made in accordance with Article XIII, paragraph 2, thereof that it is a producer State of plastic explosives.

<sup>6</sup> The Government of the Czech Republic succeeded to this international air law instrument on 14/11/94, with effect from 1/1/93. This act of succession, effected in Moscow, precedes the acts of succession effected in London on 22/11/94 and in Washington on 13/12/94.

<sup>7</sup> The Government of the Czech Republic has since notified ICAO, by a Note dated 8/12/94, received on 13/12/94, of its desire to withdraw from participation in the Joint Financing Agreements and related Protocols, effective 31/12/95. Termination took effect on 31 December 1995.

<sup>8</sup> Declaration, in accordance with Article XIII, paragraph 2, of the Convention, that it is a producer State of plastic explosives.

<sup>9</sup> Notification that as a Member of the International Monetary Fund, the Czech Republic shall proceed in accordance with Article 23, paragraph 1 of the Convention.
