To increase predictability for stakeholders, the issuance of CTOTs/CTOs had been validated as an operationally feasible concept

- ATFMUs can consider CTOTs/CTOs, instead of MINIT/MINT
- Providing lead time or exemption criterion
- Downstream ATFMU to consider issuing CTOTs/CTOs for better management of flights at the constraint point
