

Outline of the ATFM Workshop on Capacity/Demand Analysis (including capacity building/increase)

Introduction

ASBU module B0-NOPS is one of the APAC priorities as well as B1-NOPS, recognizing that ATFM implementation is one of the top priorities of GANP. Although States are requested to report its capacity to ICAO, only a few States have reported. According to the regional ATFM working group and from the 2018 DGCA ATFM break-out session, States have expressed the need to get some support on the way to develop capacity and demand analysis. Thus, the workshop aims to share the methods of the analysis and lessons learnt from States, International Organizations, and industry partners.

As increase capacity is fundamental necessity, the workshop includes topics of capacity building/increase as well.

Objectives of the workshop:

- Introduction of Doc 9971, Manual of Collaborative ATFM 3rd edition, published in 2018;
- Gaining knowledge of implementation of ATFM from States, International organizations and Industry partners;
- Case study to develop capacity determination and demand determination;
- How to increase capacity (capacity building); and
- To assist States in developing implementation plans and strategies for ATFM.

- Airspace User: airlines, militaries
- And related international organizations and industry partners
