

ATFM/CDM Workshop in 2015

ICAO APAC RSO conducts 3 different types of workshops to assist Asia Pacific States in their implementation of Air Traffic Flow Management (ATFM) and Collaborative Decision Making (CDM). Depending on States' readiness and applicability, States may wish to host and request for ICAO APAC RSO to conduct any of the below Workshops.

Foundation ATFM/CDM Workshops

Foundation ATFM/CDM Workshops are conducted to provide participants with a basic idea of ATFM/CDM based on the ICAO DOC 9971 (Manual on Collaborative Air Traffic Flow Management) and the Regional Framework for Collaborative ATFM. The typical duration of this workshop is two and a half days. The schedule for the current Foundation ATFM/CDM workshops for 2015 is as follows.

Advanced ATFM/CDM Workshops

Advanced ATFM/CDM Workshops are conducted to provide participants with an in-depth understanding of ATFM/CDM, supporting the State's needs and situation including operational constraints. Therefore, the content of this workshop aims to be State specific and may be conducted only for the State. This workshop may require a review / study on the current situation and constraints prior to the conduct of the workshop itself. The typical duration of this workshop is two and a half days. The schedule for Advanced ATFM/CDM workshops for 2015 is as follows.

Cross Border ATFM Workshops (IATA-ICAO partnership)

Cross Border ATFM Workshops are conducted by the IATA-ICAO partnership and in cooperation with Subject Matter Experts (SMEs) from States and/or International Organizations (i.e. Australia, China, EUROCONTROL, FAA, Hong Kong China, India, Japan, Singapore, Thailand and CANSO). The typical duration of this workshop is two days. Day 1 is in the form of a Seminar (classroom-based lectures) where participants will get to understand the reasons for implementing Cross Border ATFM and existing Cross Border ATFM implementations in the other parts of the world. Day 2 provides opportunities for detailed discussions to increase the understanding of various Cross Border ATFM initiatives. The schedule for Cross Border ATFM Workshops for 2015 is as follows.
