RVSM Implementation in Ulaanbaatar FIR

Summary

This information paper provides the outcome of the preliminary meeting between the State of Mongolia and MAAR regarding the RVSM implementation in the Ulaanbaatar FIR.

1. Introduction

1.1. The State of Mongolia plans to implement RVSM within the Ulaanbataar FIR in November 2011. In this regard, Mongolia has requested MAAR's assistance in conducting the safety assessment.

2. RVSM Implementation in Mongolia

2.1. In January 2010, the State of Mongolia contacted MAAR and conveyed their intention to implement RVSM in the Ulaanbataar FIR in November 2011.

2.2. A meeting was set up between representatives from Mongolia RVSM implementation team and MAAR at the AEROTHAI Head Office.

2.3. The members of the Mongolia RVSM implementation team informed the meeting of their intention to have MAAR as Mongolia's designated RMA, which is consistent with the ICAO RMA Manual.

2.4. MAAR confirmed its full support and informed the members of the Mongolia RVSM implementation team of certain data requirements for assessing the safety of RVSM implementation. MAAR also recommended that the State of Mongolia should officially inform the ICAO Regional Office regarding this matter.
