# ICAO New FPL format

The amended ICAO Flight Plan and associated ATS Message formats contained in Amendment 1 to the Fifteenth Edition of the PANS ATM (Doc 4444) will be applicable from 15 Nov 2012.

At The Second Meeting of the Asia/Pacific ICAO Flight Plan and ATS Messages Implementation Task Force (FPL&AM/TF/2) in Bangkok, Thailand from 17-20 Nov 2009, JCAB announced that JCAB is considering the possibility if we could change over PRESENT to NEW simultaneously between connection States regarding AIDC. JCAB would like to start coordination with relating States.



# ICAO New FPL format

At The Thirty-second Meeting of the Informal Pacific Air Traffic Control (ATC) Coordinating Group (IPACG/32) in Honolulu, Hawaii, from 10-14 May 2010, FAA(Oakland ARTCC and Anchorage ARTCC) and JCAB talked about the issue, and decided we use only PRESENT FPL format until 15 Nov 2012, then after 15 Nov 2012, only NEW FPL format will be acceptable regarding AIDC.

At The Third Meeting of the Asia/Pacific ICAO Flight Plan and ATS Messages Implementation Task Force (FPL&AM/TF/3) in Bangkok, Thailand from 23-24 Aug 2010, JCAB announced FPL transition regarding AIDC should only be coordinated between connecting States.

# ICAO New FPL format

JCAB will start coordination with Incheon ACC, Republic of Korea about this issue in near future.

## **NEW FPL Format regarding AIDC**

With FAA (Oakland ARTCC, Anchorage ARTCC)

until 15 Nov 2012 ; only PRESENT FPL Format  
after 15 Nov 2012 ; only NEW FPL Format

With Incheon ACC, Republic of Korea

coordination will be started soon.
