## THE ORGANIZATIONAL SETTING

The ICAO Eastern and Southern Africa Regional Office (ICAO/ESAF), Nairobi, is one of the Organization's implementation arms accredited to 24 States in the Eastern, Southern and Indian Ocean Region of Africa. The Regional office is mandated with the responsibility to closely liaise with the States, appropriate organizations, Regional Safety oversight Organizations, Regional Economic Communities, civil aviation bodies, African Union Commission and UN Agencies in the region, to promote ICAO policies, decisions, standards and recommended practices, and air navigation plans, in order to provide assistance whenever possible.

## MAJOR DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

**Under the guidance of the Regional Director ICAO/ESAF the consultant is expected to develop a State Specific Action Plan for addressing the inherent deficiencies towards elevating Effective Implementation of State safety Oversight system (EI) to or above Global Aviation Safety Plan and or Abuja safety targets (60%).**

**The Consultancy is aimed at assisting, supporting and guiding Lesotho to establish existing gaps in the Critical elements of the States oversight system with a focus on Critical element 1 and 2 (Legislation and specific Regulation). The consultant will work with State counterparts to review legislative and regulatory frameworks, develop a training framework for appropriate authority technical staff and establish the legal framework for transition into an autonomous organisation. He/she will initiate the process of developing and updating technical guidance materials.**

*The specific tasks for this assignment are as follows:*

- Evaluate the Status of Lesotho States oversight system
- Develop a strategy to expeditiously address the gaps identified
- Propose the next actions and necessary Mechanism for improvement of the State oversight system.
- Propose AFI Plan and Regional office assistance activities.

*The Key Performance Indicators are as follows:*

- Report on the specific tasks and assignments
- Strategy for addressing the gaps identified and action plan to elevate effective implementation

The consultant will be expected to develop a work plan for carrying out the assignments based on the specific tasks and responsibilities and present the same to the Regional \Director for acceptance and approval.

- b. Demonstrable Knowledge, experience and understanding of Aviation law
- c. Knowledge of AFI Plan and related programmes

- f. Proven experience in USOAP-CMA related activities will be an added advantage
- g. Proven skills in project management and report development.
