



Pursuant to United Nations Security Council Resolutions 2178 (2014), 2309 (2016) and 2396 (2017) and ICAO's new Standard 9.5 included in Amendment 26 to Annex 9 of the Chicago Convention, all ICAO Member States are required to establish an Advance Passenger Information (API) System. United Nations Security Council Resolution 2396 (2017), in paragraph 12, decides that Member States shall develop the capability to collect, process and analyse, in furtherance of ICAO Standards and Recommended Practices, Passenger Name Record (PNR) data and to ensure PNR data is used by and shared with all their competent national authorities.

In order to assist Member States in their implementation of API and/or PNR programmes, the United Nations Office for Counter Terrorism (UNOCT), in partnership with ICAO and other UN agencies officially launched the "Countering Terrorist Travel Programme" on the 7 May 2019, at United Nations Headquarters. ICAO will host an Interactive session dedicated to API and PNR during its 15th TRIP Symposium and Exhibition, to be held at ICAO Headquarters, Montréal, Canada from 25-28 June 2019.
