Appendix A

TENTATIVE AGENDA

Subject 1: Analysis of temporal RNAV routes between Santiago-Lima/Miami and Sao Paulo-Rio de Janeiro/Miami

On this subject, the meeting will be able to thoroughly examine the paths, geographic coordinates of the points of notification in the FIRs limits, the impact which the implementation of RNAV routes would have regarding airspace structure under the responsibility of each administration involved, considering that the minimum utilization level in such routes will be FL310.

Subject 2: Requirements which should be fulfilled for the trials and demonstrations in temporal RNAV routes between Santiago-Lima/Miami and Sao Paulo-Rio de Janeiro/Miami

Under this subject, the minimum utilization requirements of equipment on board of aircraft as well as the possibility of considering a 10 minute/80 NM RNAV longitudinal separation minima between aircraft at the same level, ensured by the utilization of the Mach number technique, will be examined. Also the status of coordinations between ACCs involved and other connected matters can be reviewed.

Subject 3: Review of Letters of Operational Agreement (LOA) between ACCs involved

As a consequence of the implementation of the two new routes, participants should review the letters of operational agreement between the different ACCs in order to include in such letters of agreement the temporal RNAV routes as well as the longitudinal separation minima to be applied to the referred ATS routes. A special annex to LOAs for such temporal RNAV routes would be examined until the routes turn permanent and are included thereafter to the corresponding appendix of the letter of agreement.

Subject 4: Review of the temporal RNAV routes implementation programme

The meeting will examine the RNAV routes implementation programme and will define the dates of implementation and publication of temporal RNAV routes.

Subject 5: Other matters

Any other matter concerned with the implementation of said ATS routes and which has not been included under the previous subjects, will be reviewed.
