Summary

This working paper presents information on the difficulties encountered sometimes in coordinations between Rochambeau and Belem ACCs.

- 1.1 Cayenne ACC emphasizes difficulties sometimes encountered during coordinations with Belem ACC, due to use of inappropriate language.
- 1.2 This situation presents a potential risk for safety of air navigation.
- 1.3 English should be the appropriate language to be used.
