ii.1 **Place and Duration of the Meeting**

The CAR/SAM 01/01 CNS Informal Meeting was held in Bogota, in the premises of the UAEAC's Civil Aviation Training Centre, from 9 to 11 October 2001. The area of coverage of the Meeting comprised the FIRs of Bogota, Barranquilla, CENAMER, Curacao, Guayaquil, Kingston and Panama. The objective of the Meeting was to analyse the feasibility of the implementation of Conclusion 9/8 formulated by the CAR/SAM/3 RAN Meeting

ii.2 **Opening Ceremony**

The meeting was inaugurated on 9 October 2001. Mr. Carlos Stehli, welcomed the participants on behalf of ICAO and highlighted the objectives of the meeting. Mr. Alberto Muñoz Gomez, Aeronautical Technical Secretary of the Unidad Administrativa Especial de Aeronáutica Civil (UAEAC), gave a warm welcome to the participants on behalf of the Government of Colombia and officially inaugurated the Meeting.

Mr. Juan Pablo Illeras from Colombia was elected as Chairman of the Meeting, and Mr. Patric Stern from Jamaica was elected as Vice-Chairman.
