Transition to the CNS/ATM Systems in the CAR and SAM Regions

Description of the CNS/ATM Seminar on
Institutional and Economic Considerations

(Tegucigalpa, Honduras, 30 September to 4 October 2002)

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Within the framework of activities of RLA/98/003 Regional Project for 2002 and in coordination with the Corporación Centroamericana de Servicios de Navegación Aérea (COCESNA), a CNS/ATM seminar on Institutional and Economic Considerations has been programmed, to be held at Clarión Hotel, Tegucigalpa, Honduras.

2. OBJECTIVE

2.1 The main objectives are:

- a) to discuss the ways and means of implementing CNS/ATM systems using different options or arrangements (multinational facilities, delegation of authority, etc.) including the legal framework;
- b) to familiarize planners with the CNS/ATM planning and evaluation tools; and
- c) to familiarize planners with the development of business cases.

3. CONTENTS

The main topics of the seminar will be:

- Institutional issues related to CNS/ATM implementation;
- Institutional issues related to the implementation of multinational facilities and services;
- Discussion forum on institutional issues envisaged in the CAR/SAM Regions;
- Use of CNS/ATM Planning and Evaluation Tools (PET) for the generation of implementation scenarios, their evaluation as to costs versus benefits and methodology and considerations on the preparation of business cases.

4. PLACE AND DATES

4.1 The seminar will take place at the facilities of Clarión Hotel, Av. Juan Manuel Gálvez 1521, Col. Alameda, Tegucigalpa, Honduras, from 30 September to 4 October 2002, from 08:00 to 15:30 hours.

5. TEMPERATURE

5.1 The temperature in Tegucigalpa, during the month of June is usually as follows:

Maximum temperature: 26° C

Minimum temperature: 16° C

6. LANGUAGES

The seminar will be carried out in Spanish and English, with simultaneous interpretation service.

7. WHO SHOULD ATTEND

7.1 In view of the relevance of the matters to be discussed during the seminar, it is advisable that participants be personnel of management level involved in the operational planning, economics and legal areas.

8. REGISTRATION, LOCAL TRANSPORTATION AND ACCOMMODATION

8.1 Registration will be made by the ICAO Regional Office concerned to the area of accreditation of the requesting State or organism, upon receiving their request through the submission, as soon as possible and in any event not later than 6 September 2002, of the personal data of each participant or, if it is the case, their duly completed ICAO fellowship nomination forms.

8.2 The civil aviation authority or entity concerned should timely communicate COCESNA, Honduras, with copy to the corresponding ICAO Regional Office in Lima or Mexico, the arrival information (dates and flight numbers) of their participants at Toncontín airport in Honduras, as well as their accommodation requirements. Reservations made through COCESNA will be exempt of 12% of taxes, not included in the following table. Participants staying at Clarión Hotel will count with transportation services upon their arrival/departure from Honduras, prior confirmation.
