Sir,

I have the honour to refer to my letter SA016 dated 8 January 2008, related with the above mentioned subject, in order to inform you that due to the unavailability of the Hotel, site of the event, in the dates foreseen, the Global Aviation Safety Roadmap Workshop has been re-scheduled to be carried out from **19 to 23 May 2008** in Santa Fe de Bogota, Colombia.

As previously informed, this event is being organized by ICAO, jointly with the Civil Aviation Administration of Colombia and the members of the ISSG: ACI (airports Council International), Airbus, Boeing, CANSO (Civil Air Navigation Services Organization), FSF (Flight Safety Foundation), IATA and IFALPA.

The objective of this workshop is to familiarize the participants with the GASR and clearly identify the roles of the States/International Organizations and each sector of the industry in relation to the GASR, as well as to determine the initial steps necessary to start developing a process for a regional implementation plan, incorporating GASR and the Global Aviation Safety Plan (GASP).

We would like to officially invite your Administration to participate in this event with the purpose of initiating a dialogue on the regional implementation of the Global Aviation Safety Roadmap, which was presented to ICAO Montreal in December 2006. Additional information is included in the attached **Tentative Agenda** for the workshop.

Likewise, and in order to achieve a better coordination in the development of this important issue, I would appreciate your extending this invitation to the aeronautical industry of your country.
