required: **Confirm the designation of evaluators and the participation in the evaluations of the Lima and Cuzco Airports by 30 October 2009**

Dear Sir,

I have the honour to refer to my letters LN 3/27 – SA617 and LN 3/27 – SA713 dated 7 September and 6 October 2009, respectively, inviting your Administration to participate in the First CAPSCA – Americas Regional Aviation Medicine Team Meeting (RAMT/1) to be held in the ICAO South American Regional Office, Lima, Peru, on 2 and 3 December 2009.

In communication SA617, the States were requested to designate airport evaluators in order to programme the evaluators training.

In this respect, I wish to inform you on the training activities that will be carried out for evaluators, as follows:

1. Evaluation of the Jorge Chávez Airport of the city of Lima (4 and 5 December)
2. Evaluation of the Velasco Astete Airport of the city of Cusco (7 and 8 December)

Some States have replied confirming their participation in the RAMT/1 Meeting (2 and 3 December 2009), but have not specified if their representative have been designated as candidate to airport evaluator.

In this regard, I will appreciate your assistance providing us the following information:

1. Confirm, if you have not done so, the participation in the RAMT/1 (2 and 3 December).
2. Provide the name of the airport evaluators proposed by your Administration and confirm their participation in the airport evaluator training.
3. Confirm if the designated evaluator could carry out the evaluation of the Cusco Airport (7 and 8 December 2009), in such case the transportation arrangements from Lima to Cusco should be made by your Administration.

In letter LN 3/27 – SA713, general information on the city of Lima was provided. In this letter the general information for Cuzco is enclosed. It is foreseen that the transportation from Lima to Cuzco will be on 6 December. There are direct flights between Cuzco and Lima almost every hour. The return from Cuzco to Lima can be in the afternoon of 8 December.

In order to continue with the administrative arrangements for this Meeting and the evaluations of the Lima and Cuzco airports, I will appreciate that, in addition to the confirmation of participation in the RAMT/1 Meeting requested in my referred letters SA617 and SA713, you could provide us information on the above mentioned items, **no later than 30 October 2009.**

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

**Temperature y Weather:**

The average temperature in Cuzco during the first half of the month of September varies between 10° and 17°C, in addition there are heavy rains and sun. The days without rain, the temperature can reach 22°C. Cuzco is located at an altitude of 3,400 m. above sea level (11,150 feet). Humidity average is 64%.

**General Recommendations:**

The day before travel, no alcoholic drinks should be consumed, no smoking, plenty of fluids should be drunk and be appropriately rested, food producing flatulency should not be consumed nor eat in excess. The first day in the city of Cusco you should not develop many activities, drink plenty of water and eat soft food, rest appropriately.
