Dear Sir/Madam,

I have the honour to refer to the results of the Eleventh Meeting of the Civil Aviation Authorities (RAAC/11), held in Santiago, Chile, from 6 to 8 May 2009, which formulated Conclusion 11/3 requesting ICAO to organize, in coordination with the States, a Diplomatic Conference for the drafting and adoption of the definitive text of the Constituent Agreement for the implementation of a Regional Multinational Organization (RMO).

In this regard with my letter LG 4/4 SA712, of 6 October 2009, I invited you to participate in the mentioned Diplomatic Conference and as attachment it was provided documentation related to the Agenda and organization of the Conference, as well as the Draft Constituent Agreement, which is the main document to be considered during the Conference. The documentation for the Conference is currently available at the SAM Regional office website: www.lima.icao.int.

The purpose of this letter is to point out the paramount importance of the SAM States participation in the Diplomatic Conference. The results of the Conference would lead to the establishment of a Regional Multinational Organization which would facilitate the implementation of CNS/ATM systems, as well safety issues under a multinational approach so as to obtain the corresponding benefits, for all Member States participating in the RMO, which were widely discussed in the GREPECAS mechanism as well as during the RAAC/11 Meeting.

Considering the above, I would much appreciate receiving, as soon as possible, and not later than 18 November 2009, your comments to my mentioned letter SA712, as well as information concerning your plans to participate in the Diplomatic Conference.
