Action Required **Take note and nominate participants. Reply before 22 May 2010**

Sir/Madam,

I have the honour to address you this letter in order to invite you to the Second Workshop/Meeting on ATS Routes Network Optimisation (SAM ATSRO/2), to be held in Lima, Peru, 23 to 27 August 2010, under the auspices of Regional Project RLA/06/901 - *Assistance in the implementation of a ATM regional system according to the ATM operational concept and the corresponding technological support for communications, navigation, and surveillance (CNS)*.

This Workshop/Meeting has the aim to review and develop Version 01 of the ATS SAM routes network. The corresponding proposal for amendment to the CAR/SAM Air Navigation Plan will also be prepared, and circulated to concerned States and International Organisations for approval.

The participants should be authorities, planners, and Air Traffic Management (ATM) experts from civil Aviation Administrations and ATS Service Providers directly involved in routes optimisation, RNAV-5 implementation, RNAV SID and STAR within the PBN concept.

As expressed, I am pleased to invite your administration to propose participants, keeping in mind that the reservation of vacancies will be made on a first-come-first-served basis until completing the available quota. For this reason, I will highly appreciate if you inform me as soon as possible whether your administration will send participants, and if appropriate, the fellowship submitting, if such is the case, their ICAO fellowship nomination forms duly completed, in order to receive them at this Office, not later than **22 May 2010**.

In view of the above, your administration should consider the following financing alternatives:

- a) Fellowships from an ICAO Project approved for your State.
- b) Fellowships chargeable to a Trust Fund Agreement established with your administration.
- c) Two fellowships sponsored by Regional Project RLA/06/901, for each State/organization participating in this project that does not count on any of the previous alternatives, plus a provision of 5 fellowships for non-participant States, on a first-come first-serve basis, having the interested administration to provide the air tickets to and from the host country.
- d) Own resources of your administration, in the lack of any of the previous alternatives.

The event will have Spanish/English simultaneous interpretation and the documentation will be available in both languages.

The documentation of the Workshop/Meeting shall be published in the ICAO SAM Office website: <http://www.lima.icao.int>. No documentation is foreseen for distribution during the event; therefore, it is recommended that participants bring a lap-top, or print the documentation of the workshop/meeting.

Draft Agenda is shown in **Appendix A** to this communication. The schedule of the workshop/meeting, as well as general information will soon be sent to you.

Agenda Item 1: Review of Conclusions and activities programmed of the First SAM Workshop on ATS routes network Optimisation (SAM ATSRO/1)

Under this agenda item, participants will have the status of implementation of conclusions and activities adopted during the first SAM workshop/meeting on ATS routes network optimisation (SAM ATSRO/1).

Agenda Item 2: Analysis of Version 01 of the SAM ATS routes network

The participants will have the opportunity to review Version 01 of the SAM ATS Routes Network, which was developed with the assistance of Regional Project RLA/06/901, to attend item 2.2.5 of the Action Plan for SAM ATS Routes Network Optimization and then reviewed during the SAM/IG/5 Meeting. During such meeting, States and IATS assessed a series of routes proposed by the international organisation. It is expected that participants analyse the different options presented and take the corresponding decisions.

Agenda Item 3: Proposal for amendment to the CAR/SAM air navigation plan

Under this matter, the workshop/meeting will be able to review the proposal for amendment to the CAR/SAM air navigation plan prepared on the basis of discussions up to the date in ATS routes matter. It is expected that experts initially approve this proposal, which will be circulated for its revision, validation and implementation by concerned States and international organizations.

Agenda Item 4: Other matters

Under this agenda item, the workshop/meeting will be able to review matters which have not been discussed in the previous agenda items.
