1 Background

1.1 The List of Tasks for the Implementation of RNAV 5 in the SAM Region includes the issuance of a **trigger NOTAM** to confirm the date and time of RNAV 5 effectiveness in the corresponding FIRs.

2 Discussion

2.1 SAM States should issue the RNAV 5 trigger NOTAM on the same date, seven days before (11 November 2010) the foreseen implementation date, using the following text as a model:

As announced in the respective AICs and AIP Supplements published by (name of the State), the application of RNAV 5 in the RNAV routes of the continental airspace of the (name of the FIR(s)) FIR will start at 09:01 UTC on 18 November 2010.

3 Suggested action

3.1 The Meeting is invited to analyse the information presented in this working paper and, if deemed advisable, adopt the following conclusion:

Conclusion SAMIG/6/xx RNAV 5 trigger NOTAM in the SAM Region

That SAM States issue on 11 November 2010 the RNAV 5 trigger NOTAM for the SAM Region with the following text:

As announced in the respective AICs and AIP Supplements published by (name of the State), the application of RNAV 5 in the RNAV routes of the continental airspace of the (name of the FIR(s)) FIR will start at 09:01 UTC on 18 November 2010.
