




Discovery has flown more missions than any other carrier – definitely, more than any other space ship. After 38 missions and more than 5,600 trips around the earth, the Discovery has sent satellites like the Hubble space telescope into orbit, and sent the Ulises probe robot on its way to the sun. It was the first shuttle to join the Russian Mir space station, and delivered the Japanese Kibo laboratory to the international space station. It has been the first shuttle to venture into uncharted territory on several occasions, and is about to do it again: Following the STS-133 mission, Discovery will be the first in the shuttle fleet to retire.
