

## **Rob Peters**



Rob Peters is a Dutch national and joined EUROCONTROL in Brussels, Belgium, in February 2008 as Head of the Strategic Coordination Unit within the Directorate for Civil/Military ATM Coordination (DCMAC). The DCMAC is responsible for ensuring successful civil-military and military-military coordination in European Air Traffic Management (ATM). Today Rob Peters is Head of Strategic Relations within EUROCONTROL responsible for inter alia ICAO Coordination, ECTL's support to the Global ICAO Campaign on Civil/Military Coordination and Civil/Military Stakeholder Consultation and Coordination.

Rob Peters joined the Royal Netherlands Air Force (RNLAf) in 1977.
