I have the honour to refer to the Fatigue risk management system (FRMS) seminar organized by the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) in joint collaboration with the International Air Transport Association (IATA) and the International Federation of Airline Pilots' Associations (IFALPA), which will be held in the ICAO South American Regional Office, in Lima, Peru, from 20 to 21 May 2014.

This second seminar follows the FRMS seminar held in Lima, Peru, from 26 to 27 June 2012, and has the objective to gather regulators and air operators in order to review the progress achieved in the implementation of FRMS requirements derived from ICAO Annex 6 Part I, as well as backup guidelines developed by ICAO, IATA and IFALPA.

The event will give emphasis to the requirements within the FRMS framework and practical aspects related to the implementation and surveillance of FRMS. States and operators are encouraged to participate. Simultaneous interpretation services in Spanish and English will be provided during presentations and interactive panel discussions. No registration cost has been considered.

Your administration/organization is invited to nominate participants for this seminar. Due to space limitations, it is suggested that participants are registered at earliest possible, and **not later than 14 March 2014**, completing the attached form and sending it to this Regional Office.
