I have the honour to inform you that, as per Contract No. 22501200 established and signed between the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) and INEO Engineering and Systems and Level 3 Peru S.A. Consortium, for the provision of a “new regional aeronautical telecommunications network (REDDIG II) and its associated equipment and services”, a two-week REDDIG II theoretical/practical course on REDDIG II (in English) will be conducted in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.

The course will have a 15-day duration, with a maximum participation of ten people. In this sense, with the aim that the REDDIG Administration can select the two experts from each REDDIG member State, I will greatly appreciate you inform me of the possible experts from your State that could be candidates to assist to this course, including a brief résumé showing they fit the indicated profile, and you submit it to this Regional Office as soon as practicable and not later than **28 April 2014**.
