I have the honour to inform you that the Third Meeting of the Programmes and Projects Review Committee (PPRC/3) of GREPECAS will be convened in Mexico City, Mexico (ICAO NACC Office) from 21 to 23 July 2015.

The main objective of this meeting is to analyse the improvement in the implementation of the activities of the projects of the programmes approved by GREPECAS/17 (Cochabamba, Bolivia (Plurinational State of), from 21 to 25 July 2014), the inclusion, modification and/or cancellation of programmes and projects, the approval of the results of the implementation of programmes and projects, the revision of the status of implementation of conclusions and decisions formulated by GREPECAS/17, the resolution of air navigation deficiencies of safety high risk, the implementation of regional activities as well as those of main States, the monitoring and reporting of progress in the achievement of the goals of air navigation as well as the progress in the implementation of intra and interregional activities.

The meeting is being addressed to professionals in charge of the planning and implementation of air navigation in the Civil Aviation Authorities of the CAR/SAM Regions selected as members of the PPRC¹; as well States and International Organizations interested in the agenda items of the PPRC/3 Meeting.

If the documentation is presented in both languages, the deadline is **8 July 2015**. Working Papers may not be accepted after 8 July 2015. Furthermore, I would very much appreciate your confirming as soon as possible or in any case not later than 12 June 2015, the participation of your Administration at the meeting, by returning the attached Registration Form (**Attachment B**).
