4. Registration of participants

Participants are required to register in advance with the SAM Regional Office by submitting the pertinent registration form. A subsequent registration will be made on the first day of the event, from 08:30 to 09:00 a.m., for which they must bring the registration form duly completed. Participants are also requested to wear the badge that will be supplied to them.

6. **Temperature**

The average temperature in Brasília during the month of May varies between 15°C and 25°C. The average humidity is 68%.

7. **Transport to and from the airport**

Taxi

Authorized taxi service is available at Brasilia International Airport. The rate for trips between the airport and the downtown area (hotels) is approximately US\$ 20.00.

Uber

UBER personal transport service is also available. At the airport, request the service through the application, and wait in sector B on the upper floor.

Executive Bus Service

A local company (TCB) offers executive bus service (Line 113) to and from the airport on a daily basis, from 6:30 a.m. to 11:00 p.m., along the following itinerary: Airport – *Eixo L Sul Ave.- Esplanade of the Ministries* – Northern Hotel Sector – Southern Hotel Sector – *Eixo W Sul Ave.* – Airport. 8. **Transportation to and from the Meeting Venue**

At their own discretion, based on the address of the selected hotel, participants may choose from the available transportation (taxi, uber, executive bus) for their trips to and from the Meeting Venue. If you choose to ride the executive bus to go to the Meeting Venue, get off at the airport and wait for the transportation provided by the CENIPA to pick you up 30 minutes before the event starting time.

NB.: In the city there are independent or informal taxi drivers, who, for not belonging to any company, cannot not provide security or guarantee. If you opt for an informal taxi, consider that you are exposing yourself to a very high risk.

10. **Passport, visa, and vaccination requirements**

For entering the country, a valid passport and visa are usually required. Please verify with the Brazilian embassy or consulate whether such requirement is applicable to you. Also, verify whether you need to be vaccinated for immunisation against yellow fever or any other ailments.

11. **Currency exchange and credit cards**

The Brazilian currency is the Real (R\$). Presently, the exchange rate is around R\$ 3,4015 per US \$ 1.00.

Credit cards, such as American Express, Master Card, VISA, Diners Club, etc., are usually accepted at hotels, shops, and restaurants. Travellers checks should be exchanged at currency exchange offices or banks.
