I have the honour to address you this letter with reference to the activities of the Regional Project RLA/06/901 - *Assistance in the implementation of an ATM regional system according to the ATM operational concept and the corresponding technological CNS support*, approved by the Coordination Committee of the Project for 2018, that lead to the achievement of the expected results in correspondence with the immediate objectives established in the Project Document.

In this respect, the RCC/11 Meeting (Lima, Peru, 5 October 2017), considered convenient to provide assistance for the implementation of ATS message handling systems (AMHS) and their interconnection by conducting an Advanced Course on AMHS which will be held in Santiago, Chile, from August 6 to 10, 2018 at the request of that State.

The objective of the course is to provide advanced technical and operational information about the AMHS system in order to guarantee the current operation of the AMHS and its interconnection, as well as the implementation of the needed requirements in the short and medium term. The course will be dictated by a private company specialized in this subject.

The course is aimed at technical and operational personnel who maintain and operate the AMHS system and who are involved in the implementation of the implementation of AMHS interconnections.
