UNITED NATIONS (UN) SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 2309

CANADA'S ENGAGEMENT

- The Government of Canada has been fully engaged in support of all global initiatives that aim to “raise the bar” on aviation security.
- Most recently, Canada:
 - co-sponsored UN Security Council Resolution 2309;
 - actively participated in the development of the Global Aviation Security Plan; and
 - is supporting ICAO's implementation of the Global Aviation Security Plan



CANADA'S ENGAGEMENT: IMPLEMENT EFFECTIVE DOMESTIC MEASURES

UN Security Council Resolution 2309 Article 6 (a) / Global Aviation Security Plan Priority :

Outcome 1:

- **Enhancing risk awareness and response**

Outcome 2:

- **Improving oversight and quality assurance**

Outcome 3:

- **Improving technological resources and fostering innovation**

Outcome 4:

- **Developing security culture and human capability**



CANADA'S ENGAGEMENT: SUPPORT RISK-BASED GLOBAL INITIATIVES

- Canada is a practitioner of the Global Aviation Security Plan approach.
- The most important objective of the Global Aviation Security Plan is promoting effective implementation by all States of existing standards.
- UN Security Council Resolution Article 7 / Global Aviation Security Plan Priority Outcome 5:
 - Promoting the Regional adaptation of the Roadmap
 - Refocusing financial support towards the priorities



CANADA'S AVIATION SECURITY PERSPECTIVE: GLOBAL REACH

- Strengthen aviation security globally.
- Support for ICAO.
- Financial support to monitor implementation and assist States with compliance.



CANADA'S CAPACITY BUILDING APPROACH: GLOBAL REACH

- Principal funder of ICAO's Security Program for the past 15 years.
- Commitment remains; shift to implementation of Global Aviation Security Plan framework.



CANADA'S CAPACITY BUILDING APPROACH: BILATERAL REACH

- Provide assistance and increased cooperation in accord with:
 - UN Security Council Resolution 2309 Article 7
 - Global Aviation Security Plan Priority Outcome Number 5
- Promote security capacity in States with last points of departure to Canada.
- Canada's bilateral assistance programs support risk-based, operationally viable, and sustainable results.
