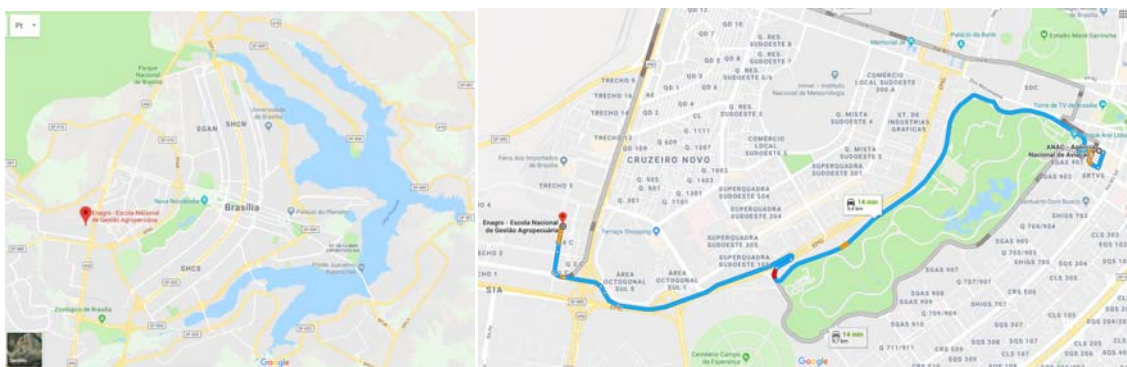

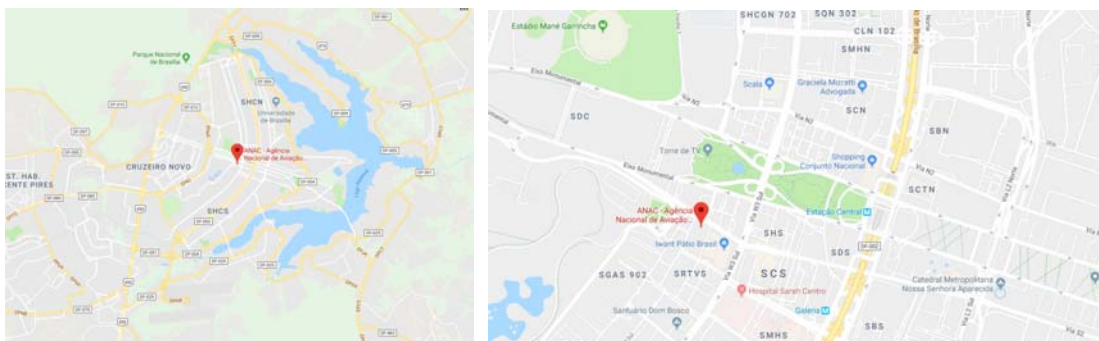

5. Weather

The average temperature in Brasilia in November and December is the same, is warm at 23°C (73.4°F). Afternoons can be hot with average high temperatures reaching 27°C (80.6 °F). Overnight temperatures are generally very mild with an average low of 18°C (64.4°F).

6. Currency and Credit Cards

At Juscelino Kubistchek International Airport you can find “Banco do Brasil” which opens at 11 a.m and closes at 4 p.m and a Currency Exchange Office called Confidence Exchange which opens at 9 a.m and closes at 9 p.m. It is convenient to change your currency at Banks or Currency Exchange Offices. Avoid changing currency elsewhere. Approximate rate: USD 1 = BRL 4,05. The International credit cards usually accepted are **Visa, Mastercard, Cirrus and American Express**. Shops and restaurants don't accept US Dollars.

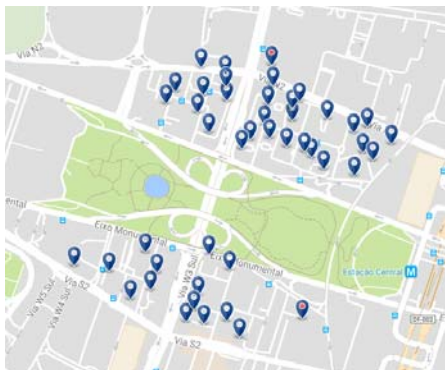

Yellow Fever

Country requirement: No

Yellow fever vaccine recommendation: yes

Recommended for all travellers aged 9 months or over going to the following areas: the entire states of Acre, Amapá, Amazonas, **Distrito Federal (including the capital city of Brasília)**, Goiás, Maranhão, Mato Grosso, Mato Grosso do Sul, Minas Gerais, Pará, Rondônia, Roraima and Tocantins, and designated areas of the following states: Bahia, Paraná, Piauí, Rio Grande do Sul, Santa Catarina and São Paulo states. Not recommended for travellers whose itineraries are limited to areas not listed above, including the cities of Fortaleza, Recife, Rio de Janeiro, Salvador and São Paulo.

14. Upon arrival

A shuttle bus service is provided by “Sociedade de Transportes Coletivos de Brasília” (TCB) - Line 113. Approx. US\$ 3.

Itinerary: Juscelino Kubistchek International Airport, Esplanada dos Ministérios, Bus Station of Plano Piloto, north region hotels, south region hotels (location of the recommended hotels), Juscelino Kubistchek International Airport. 17. Sightseeing Brasília

Since 2009 tourists who visit Brasília can enjoy, for one hour and twenty minutes, the beautiful scenery and famous landmarks while sightseeing with “Brasília City Tour” buses.

During the route, tourists will hear a brief text about Brasília and its main touristic attractions in three languages: Portuguese, Spanish and English. The iconic landmarks include the TV Tower, the Cathedral, Itamaraty Palace, JK Bridge, Alvorada Palace, the National Theater and the City Park, among others.

Inspired by sightseeing buses from capitals like Berlin, Paris and London, the panoramic buses are double-deckers and the upper deck is generally the most disputed one, once it offers the best locations to take awesome pictures.

The ticket, valid for 24 hours, costs BRL 30 and offers the hop-on hop-off facility enabling the tourist to explore the main landmarks and plan his own itinerary at his leisure.
