I have the honour to refer to my letter LN 3/24.2-SA5227 dated 11 May 2018 (copy enclosed for easy reference), inviting your Administration to participate in the **Seminar on Procedures for Air Navigation Services for the Management of Aeronautical Information (PANS-AIM)**, to be held in Lima, Peru, from 14 to 16 November 2018, under the framework of Regional Project RLA/06/901 - *Assistance for the implementation of a regional ATM system based on the ATM operational concept and the corresponding technological support for communications, navigation, and surveillance (CNS)*.

This seminar is of utmost interest, in view that its purpose is to disseminate among States of the SAM Region the process of elaboration, objectives, scope and field of application of ICAO PANS-AIM document, which will enter into force on November 2018. Special emphasis will be placed on the application of Amendment 40 to International Standards and Recommended Practices, Annex 15 to the Convention of International Civil Aviation - *Aeronautical Information Services* , as well as to ICAO Document 8126 - *Aeronautical Information Services Manual*, so that participants should be familiar with them.

It is important to mention that this event has been possible thanks to the contribution of your State to Regional Project RLA/06/901, taking into account that part of the annual quota that was sent to the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) has an item established for this purpose.

Likewise, please note that during the Twelfth Meeting of the Coordination Committee (RCC/12) of the RLA/06/901 project held in Lima, Peru, on 23 and 24 August, the use of the fellowships assigned to each activity scheduled for 2018 was assessed, noting a difference in the number of fellowships available, so a new allocation of fellowships was arranged for each activity remaining in 2018. In that sense, please be informed that the number of fellowships for the event in reference is of one (1) for the AIM area and (1) for the CNS area, for each participating State in this project, taking into account that the administration concerned must provide the roundtrip tickets.

For participants who require a fellowship under RLA/06/901 Regional Project, the *ICAO Fellowship Nomination Form* is also attached and must be completed and submitted to this Office as soon as possible, in any case, no later than **12 October 2018**.
