I have the honor to refer to RLA/03/901 Regional Project - *REDDIG Management System and Satellite Segment Administration*, to invite your Administration to the Eighth Technical/Operational Meeting for the operation of the REDDIG II digital network (RTO/8) and training on technological tools for the analysis of voice and data applications transported in REDDIG to be held in Santiago, Chile, from October 14 to 18, 2019.

Both events are aimed at technicians in charge of maintaining the nodes of the new REDDIG II network, who will have the opportunity to review the procedures for the operation and maintenance of REDDIG II, the required coordination for adjustments, repairs, shipping and receiving of damaged and repaired parts, the revision of the maintenance and operation manual of the REDDIG II and will receive information on the use of specific applications (sniffers) for analysis of data transported in computer networks.
