I have the honor to inform you that upon the kind invitation of **Empresa Nacional de Exploração de Aeroportos e Navegação Aérea (ENANA)** supported by the Angola Civil Aviation Authority, the ICAO Regional Offices in Dakar, Nairobi, Lima and Paris will organize the following events in Luanda, Angola to which your Administration/Organization is invited to participate:

- a) Ninth Meeting of the CAFSAT Network Management Committee (**CNMC/9**) and Fourteenth Meeting of the FANS I/A Interoperability Team (**SAT/FIT/14**), 3 to 4 June 2019, and
- b) Twenty-Fourth Meeting on the improvement of Air Traffic Services over the South Atlantic (**SAT/24**), 5 to 7 June 2019.

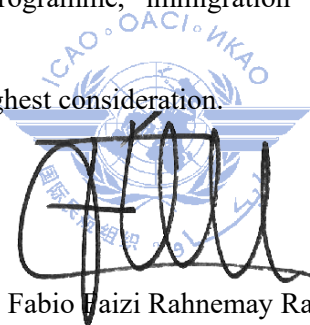

2. Languages / Langue de Travail

The Meeting will be conducted in English with simultaneous interpretation into French.

5. Instruction and Documentation / *Instructions et Documentation de l'atelier*

The Meeting will be facilitated by Experts from ICAO. The Meeting related documentation will be paperless. Participants are therefore advised to bring along laptops for access to the electronic documents.

6. Visas / Visa d'entrée

While all travellers to Angola should have a valid passport, participants shall ascertain at the respective Embassies whether or not they are exempt from the entry visa requirement for Angola. In applying for a visa, it is advisable to produce the letter of invitation from ENANA as the Hosting Organization with other documents which may be required by the Embassies. Visas to Angola can be applied on-line as well. It is important to apply for visas well in advance. Citizens from some countries can obtain tourism visa on the arrival based in the Agreement between the Government of Angola and their respective countries. For information on requirements for Angola entry visas, please visit: <http://www.smevisa.gov.ao>.

Participants from State without Angola embassy or consulate may obtain their entry visa on arrival at the fee of 50 US Dollars. In this regard, they should send a copy of their valid passport to the ENANA Focal Points indicated above for recommendation to the immigration Bureau, and provide arrival details in Luanda.

Les participants des Etats sans ambassade ni consulat d'Angola peuvent obtenir leur visa d'entrée à l'arrivée au taux de 50 Dollar US. A cet effet, ils devront envoyer au Points Focaux de ENANA ci-dessus indiqués pour recommandation au Service d'Immigration, une copie valide de leur passeport et fournir des détails sur leur arrivée à Luanda

7. Local Currency and Foreign Exchange Rates / *Taux de change entre la monnaie nationale et les devises*

- 7.1 The basic unit of currency is the Angola Kwanza (AOA). There are silver and bronze coins up to AOA 100.00. Notes are available in denominations of AOA 100, AOA 200, AOA 500, AOA 1000, AOA 2000 and AOA 5000.

L'unité monétaire de base est le kwanza angolais (AOA). Il y a des pièces d'argent et de bronze jusqu'à 100,00 AOA. Les billets sont disponibles dans les coupures de AOA 100, AOA 200, AOA 500, AOA 1000, AOA 2000 et AOA 5000.

- 7.2 The exchange rates are determined by the interbank trade which varies daily. Participants are advised to obtain current information from the internet.

Les taux de change sont déterminés par le commerce interbancaire, qui varie quotidiennement. Il est conseillé aux participants d'obtenir des informations à jour sur Internet.

- 7.3 It should be noted however that currency exchange bureaux, and banks may have different rates.

Il convient toutefois de noter que les bureaux de change et les banques peuvent avoir des taux différents.

- 7.4 Until now the Value added Tax (VAT) is not levied on most goods and services and as a foreign national; you may not reclaim VAT on anything you buy to take out of the country. There are not established formalities to complete this process before your departure at the airport.

Jusqu'à présent, la taxe sur la valeur ajoutée (TVA) n'était pas perçue sur la plupart des biens et services et en tant que ressortissant étranger; vous ne pouvez pas récupérer la TVA sur tout ce que vous achetez pour sortir du pays. Aucune formalité n'est établie pour terminer ce processus avant votre départ à l'aéroport.

8. Bank Services / Services bancaires

Commercial banks and foreign bureaux provide exchange facilities. Most banks are open between 8.00 am to 15.30 pm from Monday to Friday and between 8:00 am to 12.00 pm on Saturdays. Hotels also offer exchange facilities but at less favourable rates. Visitors to Angola can use Visa or MasterCard almost everywhere, and bank by ATM or online using the internet. All major credit cards can be used in Angola.

Les banques commerciales et les bureaux à l'étranger offrent des facilités de change. La plupart des banques sont ouvertes de 8h00 à 15h30 du lundi au vendredi et de 8h00 à 12h00 le samedi. Les hôtels offrent également des facilités de change mais à des taux moins favorables. Les visiteurs en Angola peuvent utiliser presque partout Visa ou MasterCard, ainsi que par banque ou via Internet. Toutes les principales cartes de crédit peuvent être utilisées en Angola.

9. Health Services / Services de santé

- 9.1 It will be recommended for participants to have travel insurance (including health) for the duration of their stay in Angola. Participants should particularly ensure that their insurance is applicable in Angola. Furthermore, they should carry evidence of current health/hospitalization insurance such as cards that may be produced to health institutions should the need arise.

- 9.2 Presentation of a valid **yellow fever vaccination certificate** at the point of entry in Angola will be required for persons who originate from or have travelled to States where yellow fever is described by the World Health Organization (WHO), as endemic.

La présentation d'un certificat de vaccination contre la fièvre jaune en cours de validité au point d'entrée en Angola sera obligatoire pour les personnes originaires ou ayant voyagé dans des États où l'Organisation mondiale de la santé (OMS) a décrit le virus de la fièvre jaune comme étant endémique.

- 9.3 Information on clinics, pharmacies and hospitals nearest to the meeting venue and list of hotels will be provided on the first day of the meeting.

- 9.4. Treated water is available in Angola, anyway it is not recommended to drink straight from the tap. Bottled mineral water, both sparkling and still, is readily available in most shops and hotels.

L'eau traitée est disponible en Angola, mais il n'est pas recommandé de boire au robinet. L'eau minérale en bouteille, pétillante et plate, est facilement disponible dans la plupart des magasins et des hôtels.

10. Weather and Local Time Information / Conditions météorologiques et l'heure

During the month of June, temperatures are 24/26°C during the day and during the night can fall to 18/20°C. Angola local time is UTC/GMT + 1 hour. It is fixed across the country and there is no daylight savings adjustment.

Pendant le mois de juin, les températures sont de 24 / 26°C pendant le jour et de nuit jusqu'à 18 / 20°C. Heure locale en Angola est UTC / GMT + 1 heure. Il est fixe dans tout le pays et il n'y a pas d'ajustement heure d'été.

11. Electricity / Électricité

The electrical voltage in Angola is 220/240V at 50 Hz. The plugs are 2 round pins (small), type C, E and F according to IEC standards. Visitors will likely have to obtain adapters on arrival in Angola if their types of adapters are not common outside of Angola. Please consult the internet for more details.

La tension électrique en Angola est de 220/240 V à 50 Hz. Les connecteurs sont 2 broches rondes (petites), type C, E et F selon les normes CEI. 12. Airport Departure Tax / Taxe de départ à l'aéroport
