This important workshop will be held at the ICAO South American Regional Office, in Lima, Peru, from 4 to 8 March 2019, gathering international experts and experts from our States that have under their responsibility the design, integration, establishment and implementation of these systems.

In compliance with Annex 19, States should establish safety data collection and processing systems (SDCPS). The lack of orientation and training in the way to design, integrate, establish and implement SDCPS systems is hindering the progress in the implementation of the State Safety Plan (SSP) in many of the SAM States. This fact makes necessary and very important the participation of your State in this workshop, specially addressed to flight safety directors, AIG authorities and specialists in charge of ADREP/ECCAIRS platforms and SSP coordinators of the SAM States civil aviation administrations.

With the purpose of providing orientation and support to SAM States in SDCPS implementation, the attached mnemonic paper note containing the proposed regional strategy for this implementation has been developed
