EXPLANATORY NOTES OF THE TENTATIVE AGENDA

Agenda Item 1: Follow up to the regional situation and its priorities

Within the framework of the commitments assumed by the States and industry to reach the vision of IWAF/4 Declaration, the Meeting will present a series of dashboards with their corresponding KPIs and BLs related with the GANP, GASP and GASeP global plans, as well as the progress in the development of a connectivity metric for the main cities of the SAM Region.

With this information, working tables will be established with the purpose of obtaining feedback from the Civil Aviation General Directors, on the effectiveness of Global and Regional Plans, to enable decision-making, resource mobilization and adoption of public policies, through effective and time sustainable national plans, in order to be able to reach the vision of IWAF/4 Declaration to achieve a greater air connectivity in the Region.

Agenda Item 2: Follow up to conclusions adopted in previous RAAC meetings

Under this agenda item, the Meeting will review the status of implementation of valid conclusions adopted by previous RAAC meetings.

Agenda Item 3: Initiatives for the development and sustainability of air transport in the Region (IWAF/4 Declaration)

Under this agenda item, three working panels will be organized. The first panel will deal with regional experiences in the preparation of strategic plans for the development of civil aviation, for this purpose (04) States will present their experiences. Active participation of the Civil Aviation Directors is expected in order to inform on their challenges, lessons learnt and achievements.

Furthermore, the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development – OECD will present in a panel the best practices for the States' civil aviation regulators. Finally, the third panel will address CORSIA implementation, voluntary phase.
